Submission Instructions

Prospective authors of papers describing original work are invited to submit papers electronically; up to 8 pages each, through the conference website at <http://eece.cu.edu.eg/nrsc2012>. An extra fee of EGP 40 for Egyptians and USD 40 for non-Egyptians is requested for each extra page. Publication of accepted papers in the conference proceedings and on the IEEE Xplore is conditional upon advance registration and presentation of the paper by at least one of the authors. Review papers describing new trends and state of the art of some of the URSI activities will be invited. A signed copy of the IEEE copyright form should be completed and submitted along with the camera-ready manuscript. Special poster session will host a limited number of posters presenting senior graduation project or masters' work, with free registration.

Registration Fees

Registration fees are EGP 450 for Egyptians and USD 450 for Non-Egyptians. The fees cover attending sessions, proceedings CD, lunches, and coffee breaks for the period of the conference. Pre-publication fees are EGP/USD 150. Fees are due on the submission of original manuscript. The rest of the fees (EGP/USD 300) are due on the submission of the camera-ready manuscript.
